You are registered to write the remote/online External Integrated Summative Assessment (EISA) on 08 April 2024.

	2. If using Microsoft Edge, ensure that you have updated your windows				
	version to at least a Windows 10.				
	3. Use the link: https://proctoredu.com/check to test the compatibility of your				
	laptop/desktop.				
	4. The remote examination will be invigilated live using a proctoring software.				
	5. You are only permitted to use one screen such as a laptop or a				
	personalised computer to write the examination. The examination plat				
	will not allow the connection of a second screen.				
	6. You will be required to connect your smartphone via a QR code for a better				
view of your workspace and examination room.					
	7. Please ensure that you are dressed appropriately, and your smartphone is				
charged and placed at an appropriate angle covering the full view of					
	workspace and examination room.

The South African Pharmacy Council (Council) will conduct the External Integrated Summative Assessment (EISA) for learners who successfully complete the requirements for the new Occupational Certificate: Pharmacist's Assistant Basic (part qualification), Pharmacist's Assistant Post-Basic and Pharmacy Technician.

The EISA is a national assessment leading to the awarding of an Occupational Certificate and ensures that the assessments of the Occupational Qualifications are standardised, consistent and reliable. The EISA is based on a set of Exit Level Outcomes (ELO) which describe the knowledge, skills and attitudes required for a generalist pharmacy support personnel (PSP).

Council resolved that currently qualified pharmacist's assistants (basic) and pharmacist's assistants (post-basic) intending to enrol on the new Occupational Certificate qualification as pharmacist's assistants (learner post-basic) or learner pharmacy technicians, respectively, must write the EISA.

Before the exam, please check that your cell phone number has been recorded correctly on the SAPC website.

What do you need for the exam?

- Laptop/Desktop with a camera
- Smartphone as a second device
- Pen/pencil & paper
- Reference materials
- Calculator

Please note the following profile picture requirements and the instructions to test the camera on your device.

PROFILE PICTURE

Login to the SAPC secure website and upload a suitable profile picture. The picture needs to be:

- a colour image taken within the last 6 six months;
- · of your head and shoulders; and
- against a plain background.

When loading the picture on your profile, ensure the picture is correctly rotated.

TESTING OF YOUR DEVICES

Before you write the examination, you need to check that the browser you are using can access your camera and location. You also need to enable pop-up messages.

The operating system on most devices has an inbuilt camera app. Select the start button and select the camera from the list of apps. Open the app and ensure that you can see a clear image of yourself.

Use the following link: https://proctoredu.com/check to test the compatibility of your laptop/desktop.

Please be aware of the following:

- You may not wear anything that is covering your face.
- Avoid sitting in front of a window or light source. Alternatively, close curtains or blinds.
- Ensure that your camera is correctly positioned so that your face is in the middle of the screen.

When will you receive your results?

Results will be released once they have been verified and approved by Council.
