You are registered to write the remote/online External Integrated Summative Assessment (EISA) on 23 September 2025.

Please take note of the following guidelines for the EISA:

- Please ensure that your laptop or desktop computer is updated to the latest version of Windows and that the date and time are synchronised to an online server in alignment with the South Africa Standard Time (SAST) zone.
- 2. Please use Google Chrome/Firefox/Microsoft Edge to access the exam.
- 3. If using Microsoft Edge, ensure that you have updated your Windows version to at least Windows 10.
- 4. Please ensure that you have downloaded the **QR code scanner** on your cellphone.
- 5. Use the link: https://proctoredu.com/check to test the compatibility of your laptop/desktop.
- 6. The remote examination will be invigilated live using a proctoring software.
- 7. You are only permitted to use one screen such as a laptop or a personalised computer to write the examination. The examination platform will not allow the connection of a second screen.
- 8. You will be required to connect your smartphone via a QR code for a better view of your workspace and examination room.
- Please ensure that you are dressed appropriately, and your smartphone is charged and placed at an appropriate angle covering the full view of the workspace and examination room.



Please check both your Cell phone and Email for a generated password. If experiencing any challenges with the generated OTP within the ten (10) minutes, please contact the invigilator allocated to you. Allow the SAPC to access your location, camera and entire screen when prompted. Follow the equipment check steps and take a photo when prompted. Read the examination guidelines before the exam starts. You are allowed to open multiple tabs from your shared screen. NB! Please share your entire screen when prompted. Before the exam, please check that your cell phone number has been recorded correctly on the SAPC website.

What do you need for the exam?

- Laptop/Desktop with a camera
- Smartphone as a second device
- Pen/pencil & paper
- Reference materials
- Calculator

Please note the following profile picture requirements and the instructions to test the camera on your device.

PROFILE PICTURE

Log in to the SAPC secure website and upload a suitable profile picture. The picture needs to be:

- a colour image taken within the last six (6) months;
- of your head and shoulders; and
- against a plain background.

When uploading a picture to your profile, ensure it is correctly rotated.

TESTING OF YOUR DEVICES

Before you write the examination, you need to check that the browser you are using can access your camera and location. You also need to enable pop-up messages.

The operating system on most devices has an inbuilt camera app. Select the start button and select the camera from the list of apps. Open the app and ensure that you can see a clear image of yourself.

Use the following link: https://octoproctor.com/check to test the compatibility of your laptop/desktop.

Please be aware of the following:

- You may not wear anything that covers your face.
- Avoid sitting in front of a window or light source. Alternatively, close curtains or blinds.

 Ensure that your camera is correctly positioned so that your face is in the middle of the screen.

When will you receive your results?

Results will be released once they have been verified and approved by Council.
